Dear Bowler:

We cordially invite you to participate in the 78th PNA National Bowling Tournament. The tournament will be hosted by PNA Lodge #1120 in Laporte, Indiana. Bowling will be held at Olympia Lanes MC in Michigan City. Enclosed is the official entry form due by March 16th.

We will host two days of bowling: Friday, Singles & Doubles, and Saturday, Teams. Time schedule preference will be assigned in the order entries are received. Please note that when selecting your squad choice, do not select the same time as your second choice since there are two squad times to select from.

Carefully read the rules on the back of the application. Please include in the application if you are arriving in a group, so that we can schedule your group to bowl at the same requested time.

Print names legibly just as they appear on the PNA certificate. Provide all required information on the application. An email address for each bowler is requested. We are trying to establish an electronic mailing list for better communication.

Hotel listings are on the reverse side.

Bowlers must be good standing PNA members by **MARCH 1, 2026**. If a bowler is a new member, enter new member in place of the certificate number. Team captains must provide their telephone numbers, including the area code and email address.

Again, this year, we are accepting our Social Members as a Priority 2 application this year.

PNA Members in good standing will have the priority to fill the tournament roster, however we will allow non-insured members this year to promote the PNA, its benefits and its fraternalism.

Enclose one check for all entries, including the sixth bowler when listed.

All Bowlers are required to send the latest League Standing Sheet from this season along with the USBC number. Change: Bowlers that do not have an established current average, but have one from previous leagues, we will honor that average after we check the USBC and base the average on that information. If there is no previous average established the coordinator should enter an average of two hundred for men and 175 for women. We will use 2025 scores if 2025-26 are not available.

Incomplete applications or incorrect check amounts will be emailed/mailed back to the Team Captain.
